DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highways and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highways indicating their names:

| Designated Names | "Sgt. Cameron H. Thomas Memorial Way" ¹ | "Sgt. Kevin J. Lannon Memorial Way" ² |

| Highways | The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route (SR) 48, between the intersections of Stroop Road and David Road, in Montgomery County. | The northbound and southbound lanes of SR 48, between the intersections of David Road and Rahn Road, in Montgomery County. |
| Other Information | Sgt. Cameron H. Thomas was killed in action on April 27, 2017, in Afghanistan, as a result of small arms fire during combat operations as part of Operation Freedom's Sentinel. | Sgt. Kevin J. Lannon was killed in action on October 25, 1983, in Grenada, during Operation Urgent Fury, which was conducted to protect American citizens living in the country. |
