## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

| License Plate   | <b>Paul Laurence Dunbar</b> license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by representatives of the Ohio History Connection and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. <sup>1</sup>  |

| Recipients  | Available to all applicants.  |
| Eligible Vehicles   | Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.   |
| Contribution;<br>Additional BMV Fee;<br>Use of Contribution | \$10 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee.  Contributions must be paid to the Ohio History Connection, which must use the contributions for the benefit of the Paul Laurence Dunbar House. <sup>2</sup>  |
| Requirements for Issuance                                   | <ol> <li>Submission of an application;</li> <li>Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and</li> <li>Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.</li> </ol> |
