Definition of "qualifying adult"

Modifies the Senate-passed definition of "qualifying adult" to include a person who satisfies specified criteria necessary to obtain a concealed handgun license (including a person who is legally living in the United States, who is not a fugitive from justice, who is not under indictment for or charged with specified offenses, who has not been convicted of, pleaded guilty to, or adjudicated a delinquent child for committing specified offenses, who has not been adjudicated a mental defective, who is not subject to a protection order, who is not subject to a concealed handgun license suspension, and who has not been dishonorably discharged from the Armed Forces of the United States).

Search, seizure, and detention

Removes the Senate-passed provision that specifies that the mere carrying or possession of a handgun that is not a restricted firearm, with or without a concealed handgun license, does not constitute grounds for any law enforcement officer or agent of the state, a county, a municipal corporation, or a township to conduct any search, seizure, or detention, no matter how temporarily, of an otherwise law-abiding person.
