## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

| Designated Name   | "Captain 'Smokey' Carl Edward Summers Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>  |

| Highway           | The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 42, between Richman Road and Vandemark Road, in Medina County.  |
| Other Information | Captain 'Smokey' Carl Edward Summers was a captain with the Lodi Police<br>Department who died on December 10, 1977, after being intentionally hit<br>with a motor vehicle while investigating an auto theft. |
