DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Sheriff Sergeant William 'Bill' Morris Memorial Highway" 1
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route (SR) 55, between the intersections of SR 48 and the western border of the municipal corporation of Troy, in Miami County.
Other Information	Sergeant Morris was shot and killed while responding to a call involving two juveniles trying to steal a vehicle in Tipp City.
