DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following bridge and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers on the bridge or its approaches indicating its name:

| Designated Name | "Purple Heart Veterans Memorial Bridge" 1 |
|-------------------|--|
| Highway | The bridge on State Route 304, spanning Mud Run and located in Hubbard, Ohio, in Trumbull County. |
| Other Information | The Purple Heart medal is presented to military service members who have been wounded or killed as a result of enemy action while serving in the U.S. military. It originated from the Badge of Military Merit, created by President George Washington in 1782, and was revived with its modern-day look and name by Army General Douglas MacArthur in 1932. |
