DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Murray Ebner, Holocaust Survivor and Korean War Veteran, Memorial Highway" 1
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of I-270 between Hamilton and Morse Roads in Franklin County.
Other Information	During World War II, Mr. Ebner survived four years of enslavement in four sub-camps of the Auschwitz-Birkenau Concentration and Extermination Camp, including a death march out of the Camp. After emigrating to the United States, he served two years with the U.S. Army in Germany during the Korean War.
