DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Firefighter Tommy Rees Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 142, between Interstate Route 70 and United States Route 40, in Madison county.
Other Information	Firefighter Tommy Rees was born in Columbus, Ohio and graduated from West Jefferson High School. He was a firefighter for Jefferson Township Fire Department for over six years and passed away on December 28, 2021, during a 24-hour shift.
