### SUMMARY

- Redirects the contributions (\$10 per registration) for the existing “Ohio Sons of the American Legion” license plate from the Ohio Sons of the American Legion to the Ohio Past Detachment Commander’s Club, Inc.<sup>1</sup>
- Creates the “American Legion” license plate.

### DETAILED ANALYSIS

<b>License Plate</b>	<b>American Legion</b> license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by the representatives of the American Legion, Department of Ohio, Inc. and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. <sup>2</sup>
<b>Recipients</b>	Available to all applicants.
<b>Eligible Vehicles</b>	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
<b>Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution</b>	\$10 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee. Contributions must be paid to the American Legion, Department of Ohio, Inc., which must use the contributions to support activities of the organization. <sup>3</sup>

<b>Requirements for Issuance</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Submission of an application;</li> <li>2. Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and</li> <li>3. Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.</li> </ol>
<b>Combined with Special Reserved License Plate</b>	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
