DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Officer Wayne A. Leon Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of Lorain Avenue, between 65 th Street and West 30 th Street, within the municipal corporation of Cleveland
Other Information	Officer Wayne A. Leon was shot and killed in the line of duty on June 25, 2000, after he stopped to question a man who was suspected of being involved in a shooting that occurred the previous day. He served with the Cleveland Police Department for six years.
