## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following bridge and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the bridge indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Captain Charles R. Miner Memorial Bridge"  1
Highway	The bridge spanning S.R. 11, located in Fairfield township in Columbiana County and being a part of the highway known as S.R. 164.
Other Information	Charles R. Miner joined the U.S. Marine Corps in 1957 and was selected to serve in the 8 <sup>th</sup> and I Marine Barracks in Washington D.C., where he performed ceremonial duties and protection for then President Dwight D. Eisenhower. After separating from the Marine Corps in 1959, he joined the Ohio State Highway Patrol and eventually became a Captain. After retiring from the Highway Patrol, he continued his career in public service as the Mahoning County Manager for the Ohio Department of Transportation.
