The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur about \$850 in costs for producing and installing signs for this memorial highway. Specifically, the bill designates the portion of I-76 commencing at the East Avenue exit and proceeding in a southerly direction to the interchange of that interstate and I-277 within Summit County in the municipal corporation of Akron as the Lance Corporal Michael C. Spaulding, USMC, Memorial Highway.

If memorial markers are to be located on an interstate route, ODOT produces and installs the signs. Two markers are usually installed, one in each direction at each location. Once a set of signs is installed, there are typically no maintenance costs unless the signs are damaged. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.
