## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Corporal Dustin A. Derga Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of I-70 in Fairfield County.
Other Information	Marine Corporal Dustin A. Derga was killed in action on May 8, 2005, by enemy small-arms fire while conducting combat operations during Operation Iraqi Freedom.
