The Conference Committee on S.B. 56 recommends the bill as passed by the House of Representatives with the following changes:

Specifies that policies of insurance and programs of self-insurance covering motor vehicles are not to exclude persons provided immunity under the Political Subdivision Sovereign Immunity Law (R.C. Chapter 2744) from the definition of "uninsured motorist" (R.C. 3937.18).	
No provision.	Modifies the definition of "emergency call" in the Political Subdivision Sovereign Immunity Law to mean a communication from an individual, a police dispatch, another peace officer, or personal observation and knowledge by a peace officer only if that	No provision.	

Senate Version	House Version	Conference Committee Recommendation
	communication, dispatch, or personal peace officer observation or knowledge involves or concerns an inherently dangerous situation that demands an immediate response from a peace officer (R.C. 2744.01).	
No provision.	Requires the reduction of compensatory damages recoverable against a political subdivision for a peace officer's, firefighter's, or emergency medical technician's operation of a motor vehicle by continuing law's allocation of damages according to the court's judgment (R.C. 2744.05).	No provision.
