DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

| Designated Name | "Deputy Sheriff Matthew Yates Memorial Highway" ¹ |
|-------------------|---|
| Highway | The eastbound and westbound lanes of U.S. Route 40, between Tuttle Road and State Route 54, in Clark County. |
| Other Information | Deputy Yates served with the Clark County Sheriff's Office for 15 years before he was shot and killed on duty while responding to reports of gunfire. |
