DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Patrolman Paul L. McManis Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 269 between Potter Road and Parker Road, in Erie County.
Other Information	Patrolman Paul McManis was killed on September 28, 1941, while responding to a traffic accident on State Route 269 in Erie County.
