## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Patrolman Leroy S. Bedell Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 113 in Erie and Huron counties.
Other Information	Patrolman Leroy Bedell was killed in a motorcycle accident on August 20, 1935, when a dog lunged at his motorcycle, causing him to lose control as he attempted to avoid striking it.
