## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Patrolman David L. Cole Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of I-71, between Martin Luther King Drive and Eden Park Drive, in Hamilton County.
Other Information	Patrolman David L. Cole was shot and killed in the line of duty on July 17, 1974, after responding to a call about a burglary of a local business. He served five years with the Cincinnati Police Department.
