Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments

H.B. 116 of the 134th General Assembly

Penalties

Decreased the penalty for electronic data tampering from a third degree felony to a fourth degree felony (R.C. 2913.89).

Decreased the penalty for electronic data theft from a third degree felony to a fourth degree felony (R.C. 2913.91).

Decreased the penalty for unauthorized data disclosure from a third degree felony to a fourth degree felony (R.C. 2913.92).

Attempt

Removed references to attempt from the prohibitions under the newly created offenses of electronic data tampering, computer trespass, electronic data theft, unauthorized data disclosure, electronic computer service interference, and electronic data manipulation (R.C. 2913.87, 2913.88, 2913.89, 2913.90, 2913.91, and 2913.92).

Technical change

Made technical changes (Removal of Sections 3 through 5 of the As Passed by the House version and updating of R.C. 109.572, 109.88, and 2913.05).
