DETAILED ANALYSIS

Designations

The act makes the following designations:

- All-American Soap Box Derby as the state gravity racing program.
 - □ This designation is in honor of the All-American Soap Box Derby, a youth racing program established in 1934 and located in Akron, Ohio.¹
- First full week of February as "Ohio Burn Awareness Week."
 - To serve as a week of remembrance for all who have lost their lives or been injured as a result of a burn;
 - □ To raise awareness of accidental burn injuries in Ohio; and
 - □ To educate the public on effective preventative measures to avoid accidental burn injuries or fatalities.²
- April 27 as "Ulysses S. Grant Day."³
- Last full week of June as "Pollinator Week."
 - □ To promote pollinator health and to recognize the important of pollinators to ecosystems and to the economy.⁴
