#### **SUMMARY**

Extends the immunity provided to a person who donates perishable food to a nonprofit organization to include donations to a nonprofit that charges individuals an amount to cover food handling costs, rather than limiting the immunity only with respect to donations to a nonprofit that does not charge for the food as in current law.

#### **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

## Immunity associated with perishable food donation

Under current law, a person who makes a perishable food donation to a nonprofit is only immune from civil liability for that donation if the nonprofit provides the food free of charge. The bill extends that immunity to a person who donates perishable food to a nonprofit that charges individuals in need an amount sufficient to cover the cost of handling the perishable food distributed to them.<sup>1</sup>
