## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Army Sgt. Herbert C. Linville Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The portion of S.R. 29 between mile marker 20 and mile marker 25, in Auglaize County
Other Information	Sgt. Linville served during World War II in the 37 <sup>th</sup> Infantry Division – known as the "Buckeye Division." Sgt. Linville died on July 11, 1943, while overtaking Japanese forces on New Georgia, Solomon Islands.
