### SUMMARY

- Allows employers to post certain labor law notices on the internet.

### DETAILED ANALYSIS

#### Posting labor law notices on the internet

The bill allows an employer to post notices regarding the following labor laws on the internet in a manner that is accessible to the employer's employees:

- Ohio's Minor Labor Law (excluding the list of minors employed by an employer);<sup>1</sup>
- Ohio's Minimum Fair Wage Standards Law (minimum wage and overtime);<sup>2</sup>
- Ohio's Civil Rights Law;<sup>3</sup>
- Ohio's Prevailing Wage Law;<sup>4</sup>
- Ohio's Workers' Compensation Law;<sup>5</sup>
- Ohio's Public Employment Risk Reduction Program Law.<sup>6</sup>
