SUMMARY

 Declares the General Assembly's intent to regulate carbon capture and storage technologies and the geologic sequestration of carbon dioxide for long-term storage.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Carbon capture and storage regulation

The bill states that it is the intent of the General Assembly to establish a comprehensive regulatory framework to ensure the safe and secure deployment of carbon capture and storage technologies in Ohio. It specifies that capture and storage technologies encompass "point-source carbon dioxide capture from large emissions sources and direct air capture, and the geologic sequestration for long-term carbon dioxide storage into reservoirs of geologic formations."
