DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Lance Corporal Austin B. Schwenk Memorial Highway" ¹				
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 44 between Prouty Road and Mentor Avenue, in Lake County				
Other Information	Lance Corporal Austin B. Schwenk died on October 18, 2023 at the Marine Corps Camp Lejeune Military Base in North Carolina after being shot in an on-base barracks room. Another Marine was apprehended and the Naval Criminal Investigative Service is investigating the incident. Lance Corporal Schwenk enlisted in the Marines in 2022 after graduating from Riverside High School in Painesville, Ohio.
