DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

| Designated Name | "Sgt. Cory M. Endlich Corridor" ¹ |

| Highway | The eastbound and westbound lanes of State Route 172 between 17 th Street NW and 32 nd Street NW, in Stark County |
| Other Information | U.S. Army Sgt. Cory M. Endlich grew up in Massillon, Ohio. He died from enemy small-arms fire while on patrol in Taji, Iraq on June 9, 2007. |
