## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Cpl. David A. Johnston Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The portion of the road known as Refugee Road running in an easterly and westerly direction between State Route 256 and Pickerington Road Northwest, in Fairfield County.
Other Information	Corporal Johnston served in the U.S. Marine Corps and was killed in action in Vietnam on March 3, 1969. He was a graduate of Pickerington High School.
