Adaptive mobility vehicle changes

- Modifies the meaning of an adaptive mobility vehicle by including a new or used bus, in addition to a new or used passenger car, as in the House-passed version of the bill.¹
- Clarifies that an adaptive mobility dealer also may be a remanufacturer or a motor vehicle leasing dealer without violating specified established place of business restrictions.²

Purchase and lease of motor vehicles

- Eliminates the requirement that an ultimate purchaser must use a motor vehicle as a consumer after purchase of the motor vehicle through a retail sale.³
- Specifies that an adaptive mobility dealer and a used motor vehicle dealer do not violate provisions of law that stipulate that vehicle transactions must take place on the dealer's premises when a customer executes purchase or lease documentation at a different location.⁴
