### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"Staff Sgt. Zachary Wobler Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The northbound and southbound lanes of U.S. Route 127 between Rd. 126 and Paulding County Rd. 60 in Paulding County.
<b>Other Information</b>	Staff Sgt. Zachary Wobler, age 24, was killed on February 6, 2005, by insurgent fire in Iraq. He was assigned to the Army's 2 <sup>nd</sup> Battalion, 325 <sup>th</sup> Airborne Infantry Regiment, 82 <sup>nd</sup> Airborne Division.
