Prenatal-to-Five Early Childhood to Post-Secondary Regional Partnerships Program	
No provision.	Establishes the Prenatal-to-Five Early Childhood to Post-Secondary Regional Partnerships Program to support early childhood to post-secondary regional partnerships throughout Ohio (<i>R.C. 3301.85</i>).
No provision.	Appropriates \$2 million in FY 2025 to support the program (<i>Section 3</i>).
State Board of Education Licensure Fund	
No provision.	Requires the Director of Budget and Management to transfer \$4,660,500 from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board of Education Licensure Fund on the bill's effective date or as soon as possible thereafter (<i>Section 5</i>).
