CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following memorial highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the roadway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Memorial Highway
The "Lt. Col. Albert L. Allen, Jr. Memorial Highway" ¹	The portion of Interstate Route 71, commencing at the southwest boundary of Ashland County and proceeding in a southwesterly direction to the interchange of that interstate highway and State Route 39 in Richland County

COMMENT

Lt. Col. Albert L. Allen, Jr. died in Mansfield, Ohio on August 14, 2004; he served in the Army during World War II and in the Army Reserves following the war.
