## **BILL SUMMARY**

• Delays by one week the date of a presidential primary election.

## **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill delays by one week the date of a presidential primary election. Under the bill, such an election must be held on the *second* Tuesday after the first Monday in March instead of on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in March.<sup>1</sup>

As a result, under the bill, the corresponding deadlines associated with the date of the presidential primary are delayed by one week. For example, the bill delays the deadline for a candidate to submit a nominating petition to appear on the ballot and the deadline to submit a ballot issue to appear on the ballot at a special election held on the day of a presidential primary election.<sup>2</sup>
