BILL SUMMARY

The bill designates the following roadways and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the roadways:

Designated Name	Roadway
The "Army Chief Warrant Officer Donald V. Clark Memorial Highway" ¹	A portion of S.R. 7, commencing at the intersection of S.R. 7 and West Western Reserve Road and East Western Reserve Road and proceeding in a northerly direction to the intersection of S.R. 7 and U.S. Route 224 within Mahoning County
The "Sergeant Adam L. Knox Memorial Highway" ²	A portion of I-70, commencing at the interchange of I-70 and North Wilson Road and proceeding in a westerly direction to the interchange of I-70 and Hilliard Rome Road within Franklin County
