BILL SUMMARY

- Designates a portion of I-70, commencing at the interchange of I-70 and North Wilson Road and proceeding in a westerly direction to the interchange of I-70 and Hilliard Rome Road within Franklin County, as the "Sergeant Adam L. Knox Memorial Highway."
- Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name.¹

U.S. Army Sergeant Adam L. Knox died on September 17, 2006, while serving in Baghdad, Iraq.
