Substitute Bill Comparative Synopsis

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

PCSA care of child	
<p>Requires, on receipt of notice from a court or law enforcement officer that a child has been taken into custody and cannot be released to the child's parent, guardian, or legal custodian, a public children services agency (PCSA) to take immediate <i>custody</i> of the child (R.C. 2151.31(D)).</p> <p>Requires, if the child is taken into PCSA custody in a county other than the county in which the child resides, the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The PCSA to act as the temporary custodial agency for the child and immediately notify the PCSA of the county where the child resides; and ▪ The PCSA of the county where the child resides to promptly take custody of the child and act as the lead agency. <p>(R.C. 2151.31(D)(2).)</p>	<p>Instead, requires the PCSA to take immediate <i>temporary emergency care</i> of the child (R.C. 2151.31(D)).</p> <p>Requires the PCSA to provide temporary emergency care of the child until the child can be released to an appropriate caregiver or to the PCSA of the county where the child resides (R.C. 2151.31(D)(2)).</p>
