#### CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
The "Governor Richard F. Celeste Shoreway" <sup>1</sup>	The portion of S.R. 2 located in Cuyahoga County and also known as the Cleveland Memorial Shoreway, commencing at Lake Avenue and extending in an easterly direction to the point at which the road crosses the Cuyahoga River

Governor Celeste served two terms as governor of Ohio, from 1983 to 1991.
