SUMMARY

- Makes capital reappropriations for the biennium ending June 30, 2028 (FYs 2027 and 2028) and other appropriations.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Capital reappropriations

The bill reappropriates approximately \$1.93 billion in capital funds for the biennium ending June 30, 2028 (FYs 2027 and 2028). For more details, consult the Legislative Budget Office's Fiscal Note for [H.B. 730](#), which is available on the General Assembly's website: legislature.ohio.gov.

Other appropriations

The bill makes the following supplemental appropriations:

- Requires the Department of Job and Family Services (JFS) and the Department of Medicaid to contract with a qualified third-party vendor to conduct a comprehensive assessment of the financial network disbursement systems used by each department and appropriates \$500,000 for FY 2027.
- Makes supplemental appropriations for a variety of state agencies totaling \$14,169,360 in FY 2026 and \$39,336,679 in FY 2027.

* This analysis was prepared before the report of the House Finance Committee appeared in the House Journal. Note that the legislative history may be incomplete.

- Makes supplemental appropriations of \$12.5 million to JFS in FY 2027 to allocate to county departments of job and family services to administer the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP).
