SUMMARY

- Makes capital reappropriations for the biennium ending June 30, 2028 (FYs 2027 and 2028) and other appropriations.
- Makes various supplemental appropriations and earmarks.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Capital reappropriations

The bill reappropriates approximately \$1.93 billion in capital funds for the biennium ending June 30, 2028 (FYs 2027 and 2028). For more details, consult the Legislative Budget Office's Fiscal Note for [H.B. 730](#).¹

Other appropriations

The bill makes the following supplemental appropriations and earmarks:

- Makes supplemental appropriations for a variety of state agencies totaling \$14.2 million in FY 2026 and \$52.3 million in FY 2027;²
- Earmarks \$500,000 in FY 2027 for the Department of Job and Family Services (JFS) and the Department of Medicaid to contract with a qualified third-party vendor to conduct a comprehensive assessment of the financial network disbursement systems used by each department;³

- Earmarks a total of \$12.5 million to JFS in FY 2027 to allocate to county departments of job and family services to administer the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program.⁴
