### State Fiscal Highlights

### **Local Fiscal Highlights**

No direct fiscal effect on political subdivisions.

#### **Detailed Fiscal Analysis**

The bill permits a first responder, emergency medical technician, or volunteer firefighter to take action to stabilize an injured animal before the animal is transferred to a veterinarian for further treatment. Any costs incurred by a local jurisdiction, such as training and civil liability, would be a function of a local jurisdiction exercising its authority to permit certain staff to perform this service; the bill does not require it. It also appears that the bill generally may codify current practice.
