Sub. Bill Comparative Synopsis

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H.B. 113

131st General Assembly (H. Education)

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Topic	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (LSC 131 0904-2)
CPR/AED instruction in high school	Beginning with students who enter the 9th grade for the first time on or after July 1, 2016, requires instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and the use of an automatic external defibrillator (AED) as a high school graduation requirement for public and chartered nonpublic schools. (R.C. 3313.603(C)(2)(b) and 3313.6021; conforming changes in R.C. 3313.60(A)(8), 3314.03(A)(11)(d), 3326.11, and 3328.24.)	Beginning with the 2016-2017 school year (rather than with students entering 9th grade for the first time on or after July 1, 2016), requires that most public schools provide instruction in CPR and use of an AED for grades 9-12 but does not require it for high school graduation. (R.C. 3313.60(A)(8), 3313.6021, 3326.11, and 3328.24; removes 3313.603 from the bill.)
	Requires all public schools (school district-operated schools, community schools, STEM schools, and college-prep boarding schools) and chartered nonpublic schools to comply with the CPR/AED instruction requirements. (R.C. 3313.603(C)(2)(b), 3313.6021, 3314.03(A)(11)(d), 3326.11, and 3328.24.)	Does not require community schools and chartered nonpublic schools to comply with the CPR/AED instruction requirements. (Removes R.C. 3314.03 from the bill and revises R.C. 3313.6021.)

Topic	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (LSC 131 0904-2)
Monitoring and consequences for noncompliance	Requires the Department of Education to establish a procedure to monitor compliance with the requirement to provide CPR and use of AED instruction and permits the Department to withhold a percentage of state funds from a district or school that fails to comply with the requirement. (R.C. 3313.6021(E).)	No provision.
AED training for school district employees	No provision. No provision.	Requires school districts to provide training in the use of an AED to each person employed by that district. (R.C. 3313.6023 and 3313.717.) Requires each employee of a school district to receive training in the use of an AED not later than July 1, 2017, and once every five years thereafter. (R.C. 3313.6023.)

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
