• Designates November 10 as "Armed Services, Peace Officer, First Responder, and Dual Service Recognition Day."

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The act designates November 10 as "Armed Services, Peace Officer, First Responder, and Dual Service Recognition Day" to recognize and honor, as twice the servants, individuals who have served, or who are serving, in the armed forces and also have served, or who are serving, as a police officer or other first responder.
