BILL SUMMARY

• Changes the name of the Ohio Historical Society to the Ohio History Connection.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill changes the name of the Ohio Historical Society to the Ohio History Connection throughout the Revised Code.

The Ohio Historical Society is chartered by the state as a nonprofit corporation to promote knowledge of history and archaeology, especially of Ohio, and has been operated continuously in the public interest since 1885.¹ The Ohio Historical Society performs many duties, including operating the Ohio Historical Center and Ohio Village, keeping Ohio's original documents, such as its constitutions,² operating and restoring state museums, monuments, and earthworks, serving as the archives administrator for the state and its political subdivisions, and publishing documents about history, archaeology, and natural science.³
