### **BILL SUMMARY**

• Changes the name of the Ohio Historical Society to the Ohio History Connection.

#### **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill changes the name of the Ohio Historical Society to the Ohio History Connection throughout the Revised Code.

The Ohio Historical Society is chartered by the state as a nonprofit corporation to promote knowledge of history and archaeology, especially of Ohio, and has been operated continuously in the public interest since 1885.<sup>1</sup> The Ohio Historical Society performs many duties, including operating the Ohio Historical Center and Ohio Village, keeping Ohio's original documents, such as its constitutions,<sup>2</sup> operating and restoring state museums, monuments, and earthworks, serving as the archives administrator for the state and its political subdivisions, and publishing documents about history, archaeology, and natural science.<sup>3</sup>
