Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments*

131st General Assembly (S. State & Local Government)

Outdoor refreshment areas

Allows a municipal corporation or township with a population of 35,000 or less, beginning two years after the bill's effective date, to create one outdoor refreshment area if the proposed area will: (1) include at least four A-1, A-1-A, A-1c, A-2, or D liquor permit holders and (2) be composed of 150 or fewer contiguous acres.

Eliminates the Outdoor Refreshment Area Study Committee.

F-8 liquor permits

Authorizes an F-8 liquor permit (allows alcohol sales at special events held on public property) to be issued in a county that has a population of more than 750,000 on or after the bill's effective date, rather than in a county that has a population of between 750,000 and 900,000 on July 10, 2007 as under current law.
