BILL SUMMARY

• Designates both of the following portions of State Route 123 in Warren County as the "Neil Armstrong Memorial Way":

--The portion commencing at the intersection of S.R. 123 and S.R. 122 on the east side of the community of Red Lion and proceeding in a southerly direction to the intersection of S.R. 123 and Hart Road within the municipal corporation of Lebanon; and

--Within the municipal corporation of Lebanon, the portion of S.R. 123 known as the S.R. 123 bypass, commencing at the intersection of the bypass and Hart Road and proceeding in a southerly direction to the intersection of the bypass and S.R. 63.

• Authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along those portions of the highway indicating their name.¹

COMMENT

Neil Armstrong was born in Ohio and on July 20, 1969, became the first person to walk on the moon.
