CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following memorial highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the roadway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Memorial Highway
The "John W.E. Bowen III Memorial Roadway" (R.C. 5534.50)	The portion of U.S. Route 33, commencing at the intersection of East Livingston Avenue and College Avenue in Columbus and proceeding in a southerly direction to the intersection of U.S. Route 33 and S.R. 104
