Contents: Prescribes the fiduciary duties of corporate and limited liability company officers and makes other modifications to the Limited Liability Company Law

Detailed Fiscal Analysis

The bill revises the persons considered to be directors or officers of corporations, makes provisions concerning the fiduciary duties of an officer of a corporation, modifies the content of an operating agreement of a Limited Liability Company (LLC), modifies provisions pertaining to freedom of contract and member's duty of loyalty to LLCs, specifies that an LLC may have, but is not required to have, officers and outlines provisions concerning the liability of these officers. These provisions are explained in detail in the LSC bill analysis. None of the bill's provisions have a fiscal impact on the state or political subdivisions.
