#### **Detailed Fiscal Analysis**

The bill designates the 16th day of October as "George Washington Williams Day" in honor of the civil war veteran, minister, politician, lawyer, and historian who was born on that day in 1849. The bill encourages elementary and secondary schools in the state to observe the day by discussing the life of George Washington Williams. This bill has no effect on public revenues or expenditures.
