## Synopsis of Senate Committee Amendments\*

Sub. H.B. 56

131st General Assembly (S. State & Local Government)

Specifies that the provision in the House-passed version prohibiting a public employer from including any question concerning an applicant's criminal background on any employment application does not prohibit a public employer from including a notification on that application regarding any provision of Ohio or federal law that disqualifies an individual with a particular criminal history from employment in a particular position.

Specifies that certain independent providers are not employees of the state or a political subdivision.

Limits the disqualification from resuming a position in the classified service in the Department of Rehabilitation and Correction for a felony conviction to a conviction while in the civil service, similar to the disqualification from fallback rights for other state employees under the House-passed version of the bill.
