#### **BILL SUMMARY**

The bill designates the following roadways and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the roadways:

Designated Name	Bridge
The "Army Specialist Gerald R. Jenkins Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	A portion of U.S. Route 23, running in a northerly and southerly direction, commencing at its intersection with Island Road and extending to its intersection with Little Walnut Road, within Pickaway County
The "Army PFC Kevin C. Ott Memorial Highway" <sup>2</sup>	The portion of U.S. Route 62 within Pickaway County

#### COMMENT

Army Specialist Gerald R. Jenkins died on October 20, 2010, in Maquan, Zhari district, Afghanistan while serving in Operation Enduring Freedom.

Army PFC Kevin C. Ott was killed in action in Iraq in June 2003 while serving in Operation Iraqi Freedom.
